Subject: Regional Capacity Charge for FY 2013-14  
CMSA Fee Schedule Ordinance Number 2013-2

Enclosed is the CMSA Fee Schedule Ordinance Number 2013-2 for the CMSA regional sewer capacity charge effective July 1, 2013. Pursuant to Section 4 of CMSA Fee Schedule Ordinance Number 2013-2, the capacity charge shall be automatically adjusted each July 1 by an increment based on the change in the Engineering News-Record Construction Cost Index (ENR Index) for San Francisco. The Ordinance set the base ENR Index for April 2012 at 10371.29. The ENR Index for April 2012 was 10371.29 and April 2013 was 10373.34. This represents an incremental increase of 0.02% from April 2012 to April 2013.
